Investment Approach
Janus Capital Management, LLC primarily invests in U.S. and global stocks across all market capitalizations, but also considers convertibles, MLP, and preferred stocks for investments. The firm is a growth investor. Janus uses proprietary fundamental research and builds a detailed financial model for each stock under consideration that looks at: (a) business plans; (b) product/services currently offered or in development; and; (c) pricing. The firm's bottom up research effort includes: (a) analysis of competitors and suppliers; (b) demographic trends; (c) on-site visits; (d) media coverage; and; (e) other qualitative factors. Janus also emphasizes frequent visits with corporate management, employees, and customers. The firm considers selling a position when: (a) the company or industry fundamentals change, or competitive advantage deteriorates; (b) the share price reflects the target price; (c) there is a change in investment process; (d) portfolio is upgraded with a new idea; and; (e) position needs to be adjusted based on risk monitoring practice.
